> BRUTAL murders, traumatic suicides and incidents of workplace bullying are prompting police officers to lodge stress claims at a rate of one a week.

Figures obtained under Freedom of Information show that 217 claims under the police worker's compensation scheme were lodged with SA Police in the four years to June 30 this year — averaging one claim every week.

Of these, 147 were accepted under the scheme.






